Tucker Pride is creating a community activity and coloring book, and we want your artwork to be part of it. This book will celebrate Pride, creativity, and what makes our community special—and your drawings will help bring it to life.

You don't have to be a professional artist. If you love to draw, imagine, and create, we want to see what you can do!

## What We're Looking For

We're looking for fun, positive, and creative drawings that people can color in. Your artwork should make people smile, feel included, and celebrate being themselves.

Your drawing can be:

- Silly or serious
- Simple or detailed
- Realistic or totally imaginative

Most importantly—it should feel happy, welcoming, and expressive.

## Ideas to Get You Started

If you're not sure what to draw, here are some ideas to inspire you:

### Pride & Identity

- Pride flags, rainbows, and hearts
- People being proud of who they are
- Messages like "You Are Loved" or "Be Yourself"

- Friends supporting each other

## Fun & Imaginative

- Unicorns, dragons, or magical creatures
- Animals wearing Pride colors or accessories
- Fantasy worlds full of color and joy
- Characters that represent YOU

## Community & Tucker

- Parks, buildings, or places in Tucker
- People hanging out, playing games, or celebrating
- Community events or festivals
- (Tucker themes are welcome—but totally optional!)

## Everyday Joy

- Smiling faces and happy moments
- Families and friendships
- Kindness, love, and belonging

## How to Create Your Artwork

Since this is a coloring book, your drawing should be something others can color in.

Here's how to make it work best:

- Draw using black lines only (like a coloring page)
- Use clear outlines and shapes
- Leave spaces inside your drawing so people can color them
- Avoid coloring it in yourself (we want others to do that part!)
- You can use AI for inspiration, but please only submit human-created art

Try to:

- Make shapes big enough to color easily
- Not include too many tiny details
- Keep your lines dark and easy to see

## Page Size

- Draw your artwork to fit on a standard sheet of paper (8.5 × 11 inches)
- Keep your drawing away from the edges so nothing gets cut off

## How to Submit

Include:

- Your name
- Title of your artwork (if you have one)
- Your age (optional)
- A short sentence about your drawing (optional)

If your file is too big, you can send a link (Google Drive, etc.)

Our team will review all submissions and select artwork for the book. If your artwork is chosen:

- You'll be credited in the book 🎨
- Your art will be shared with the community
- You'll be part of something really special
